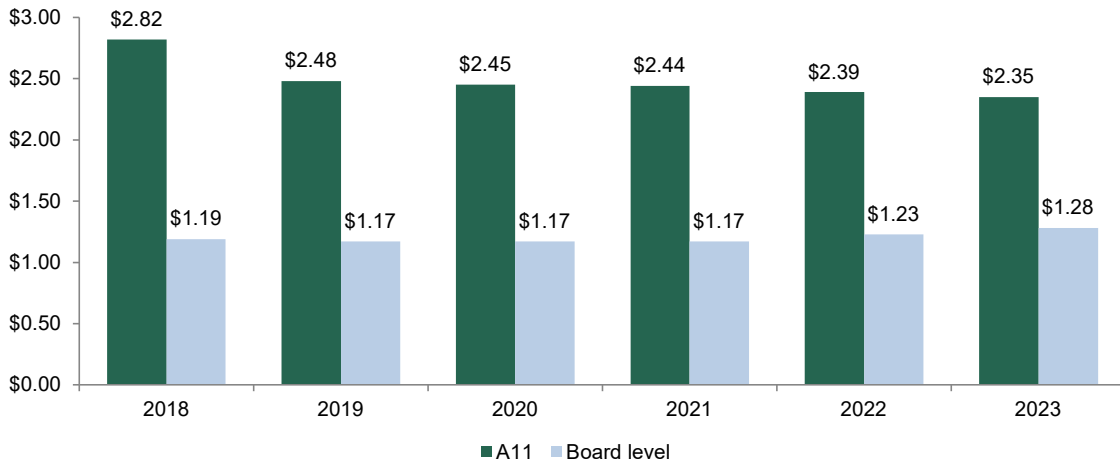

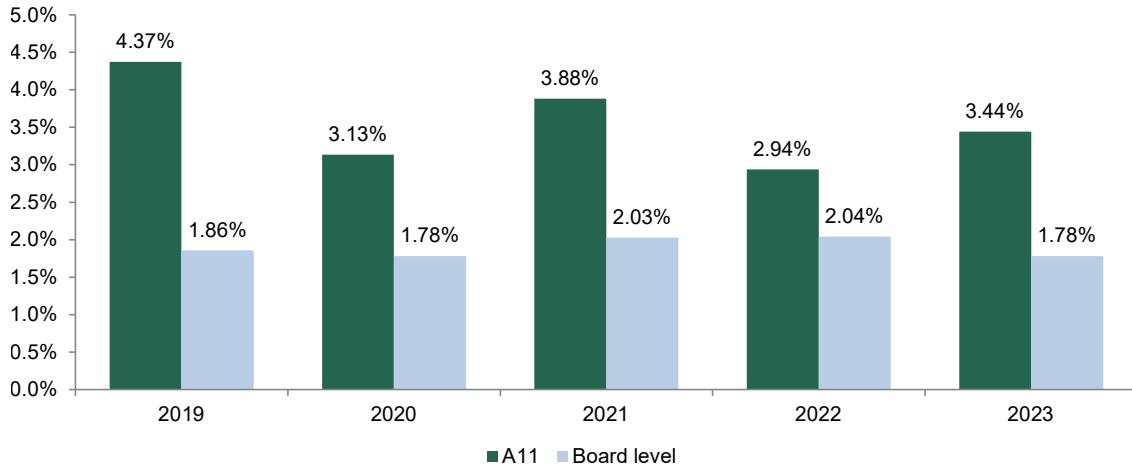

Premium rates - per \$100 assessable payroll



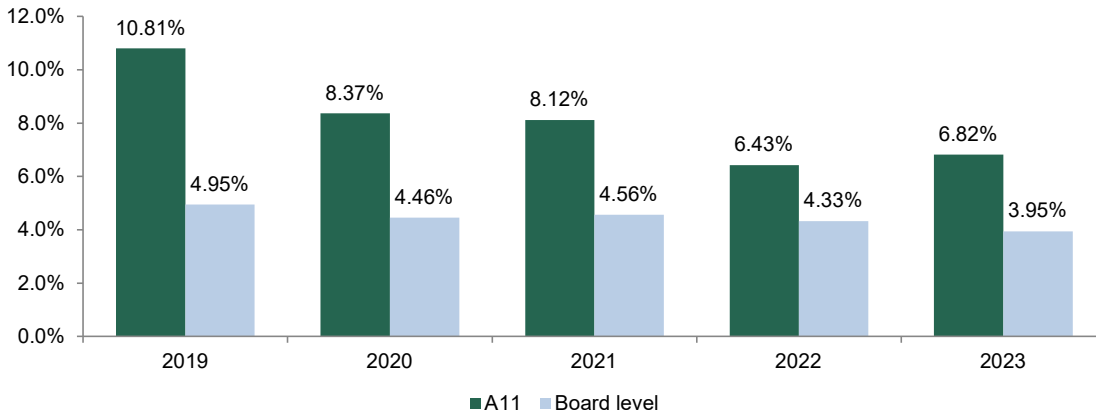

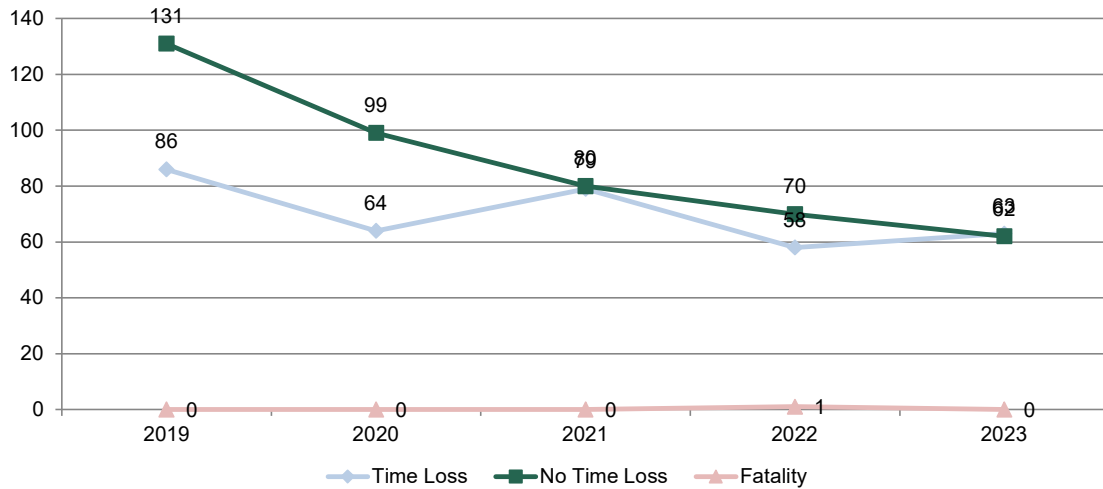
Total injury rates**

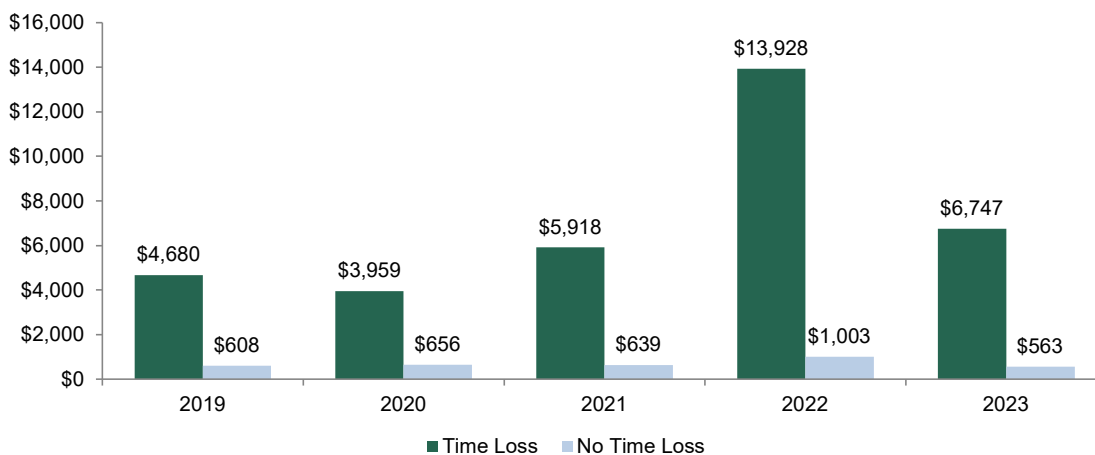

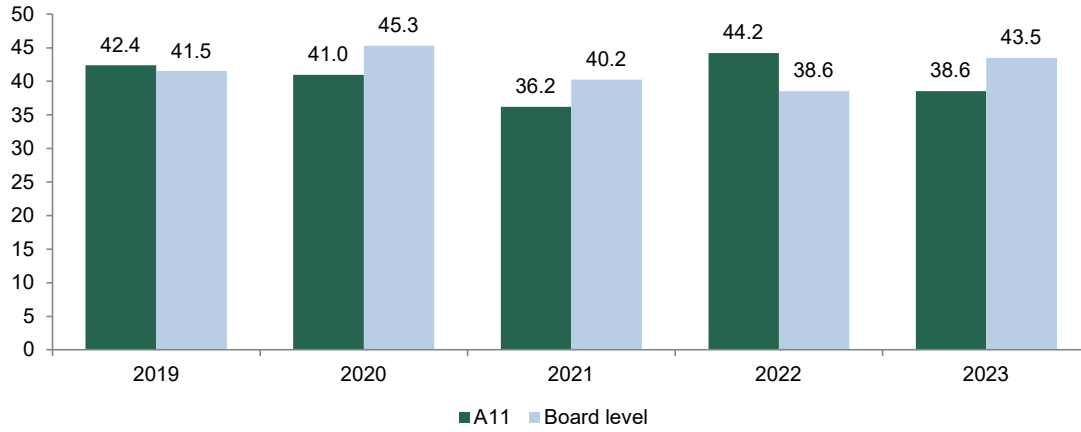
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

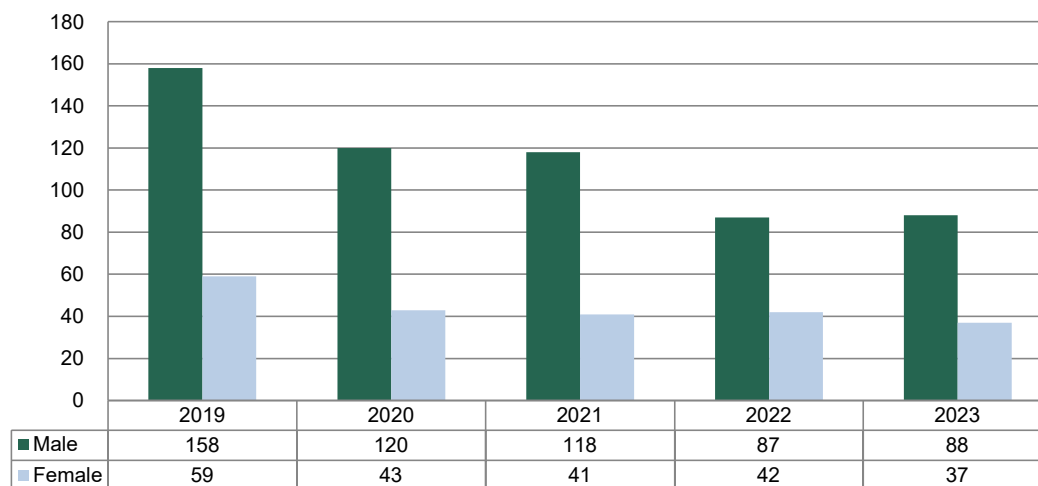

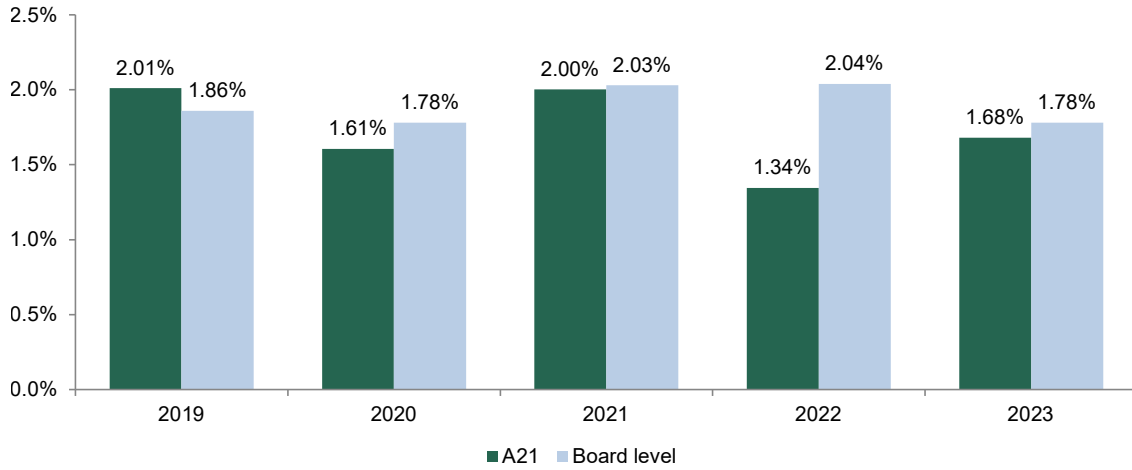

Premium rates - per \$100 assessable payroll



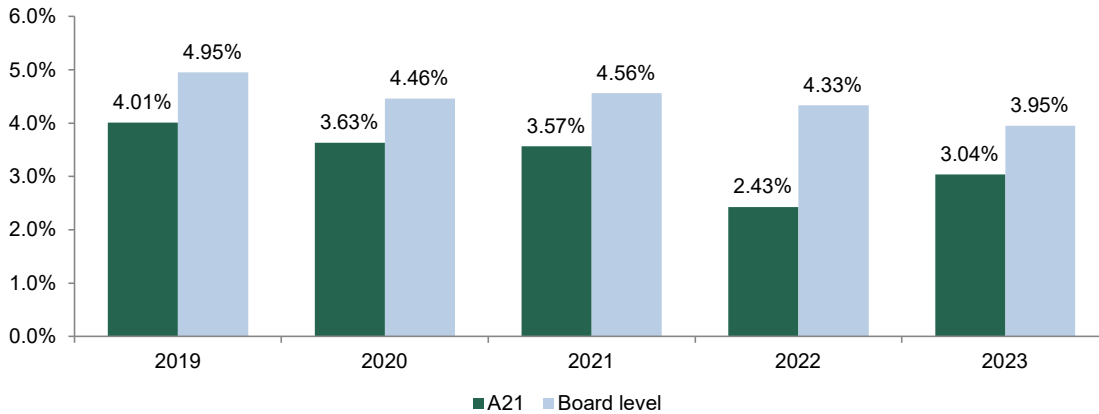

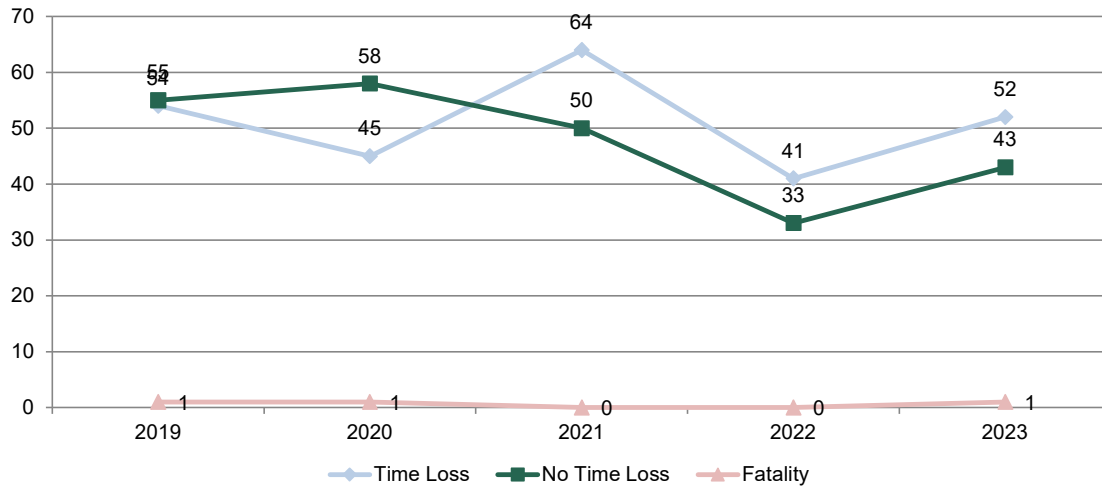
Total injury rates**

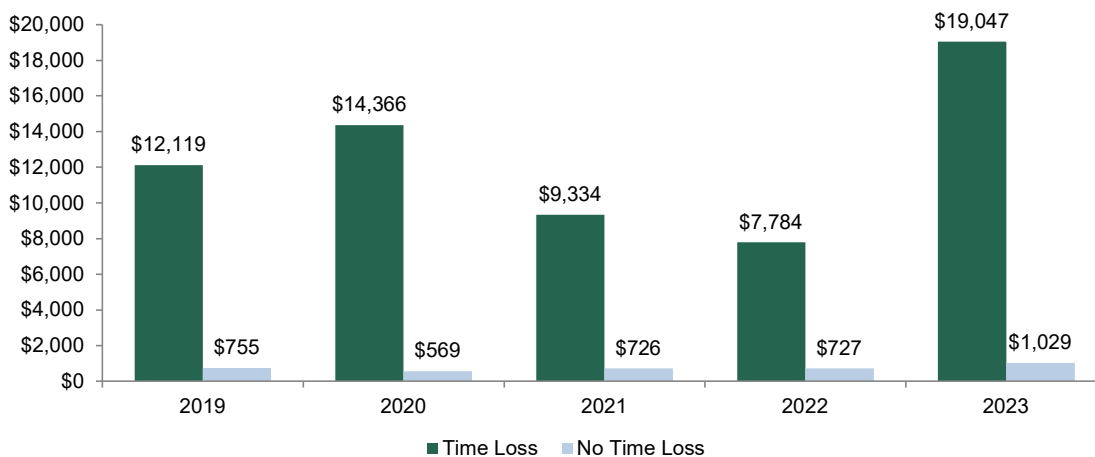

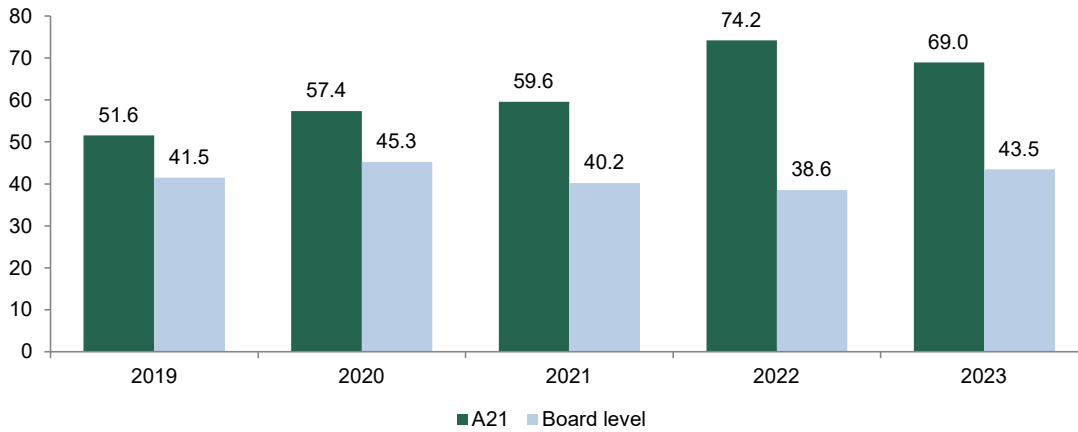
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

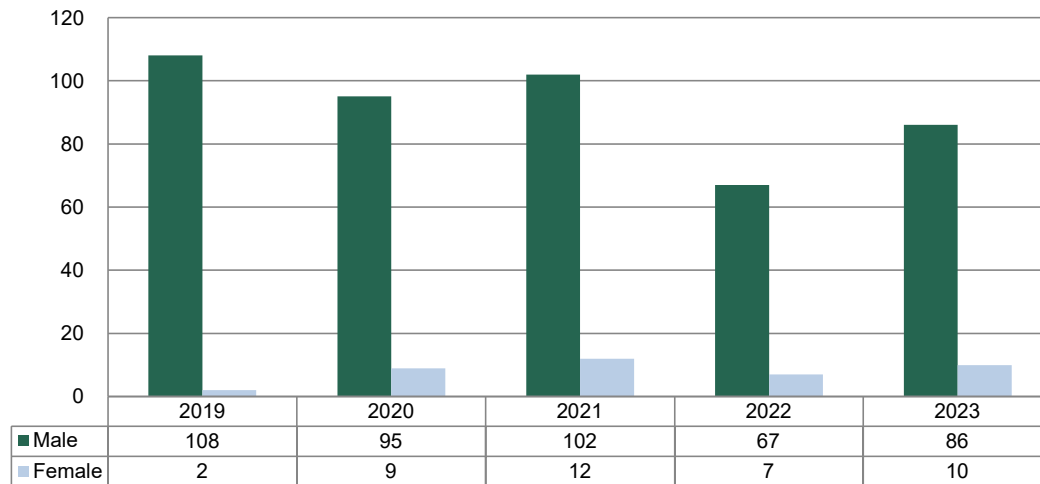

Premium rates - per \$100 assessable payroll



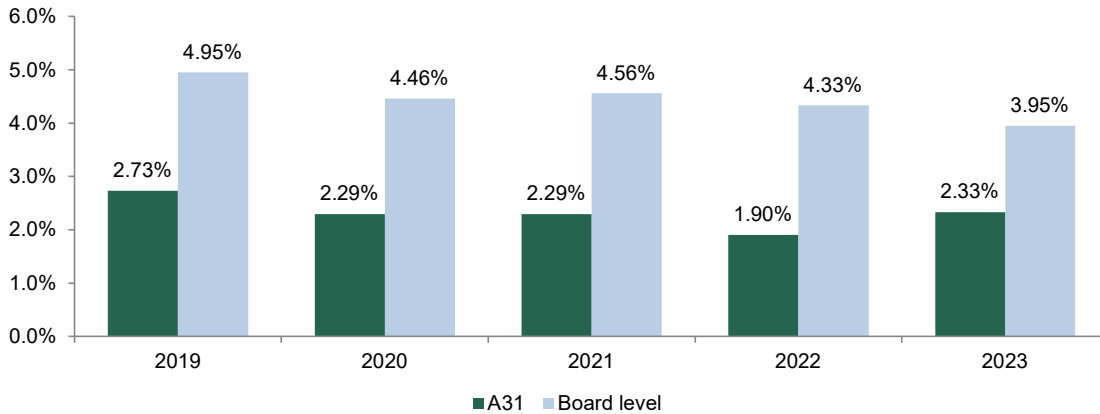

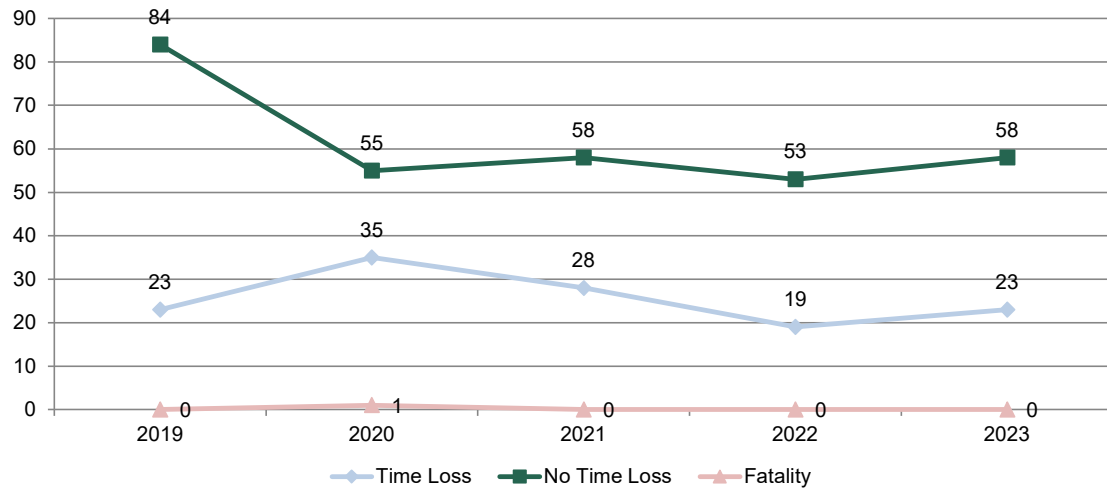
Total injury rates**

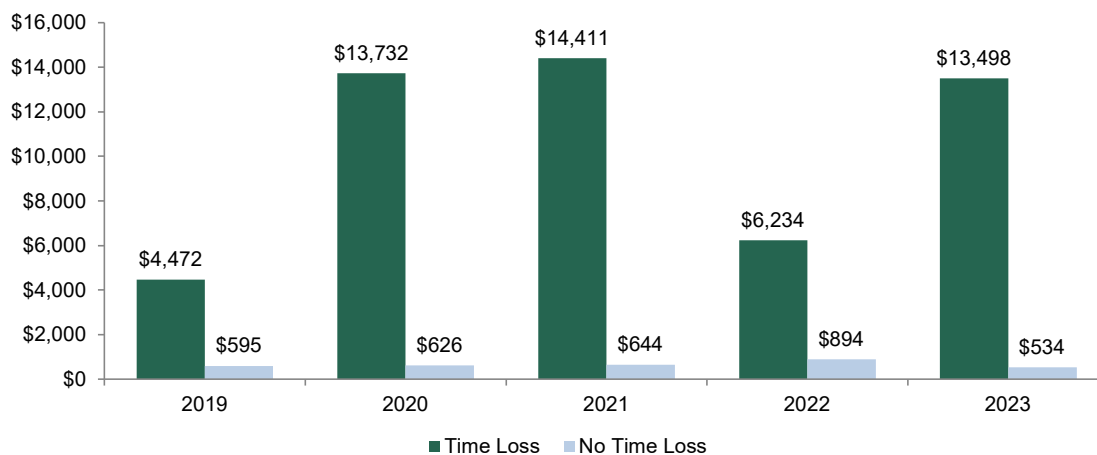

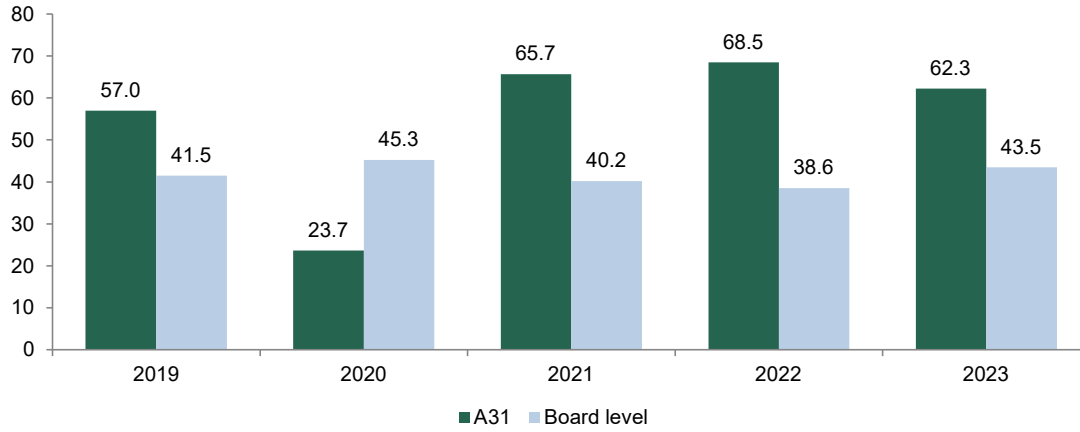
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

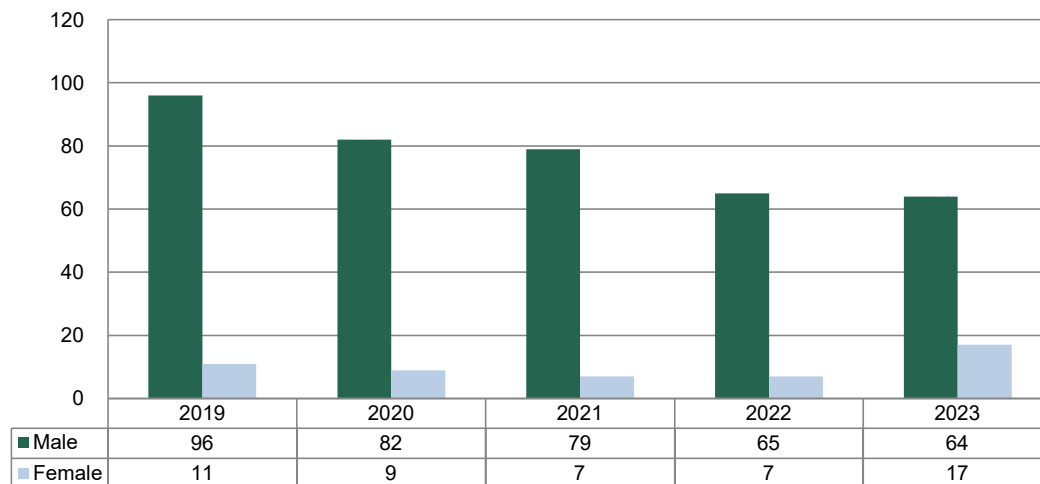

Premium rates - per \$100 assessable payroll



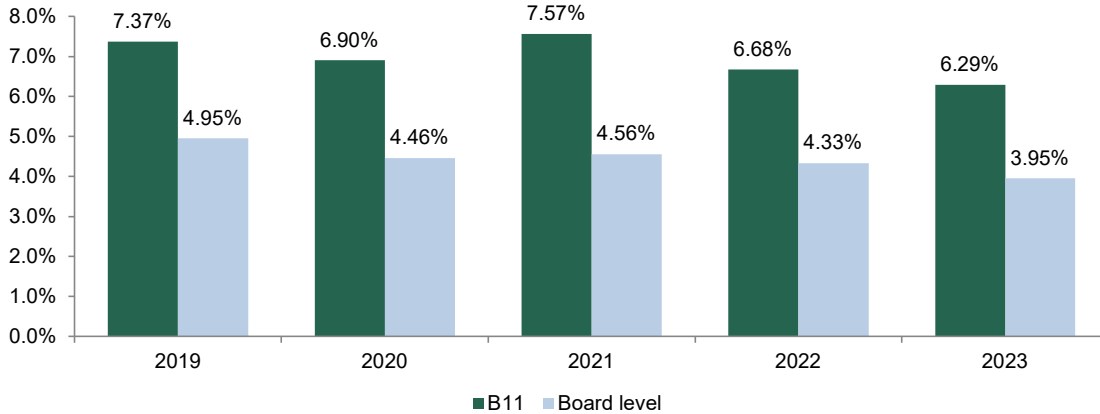

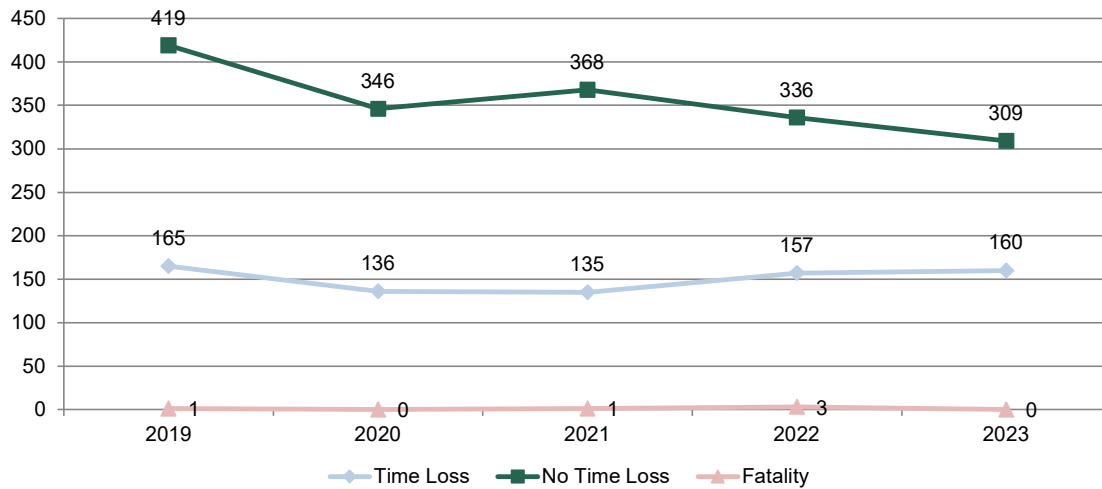

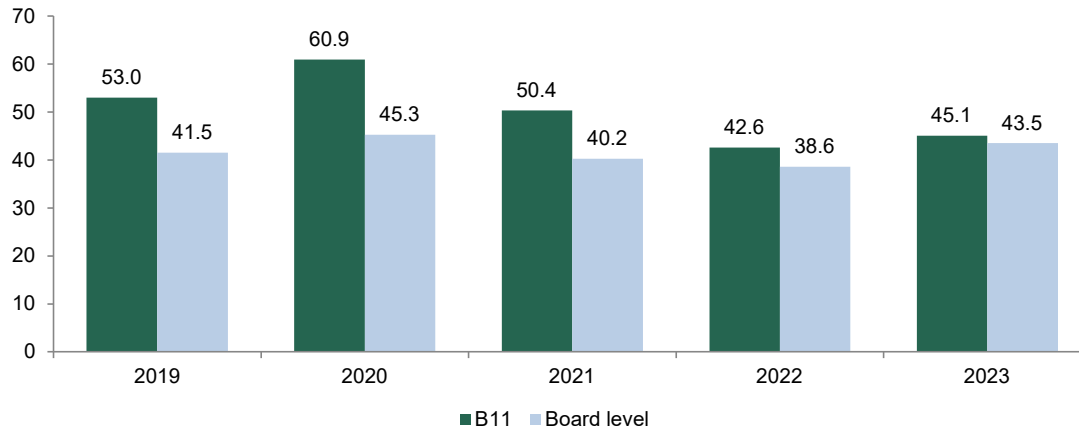
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

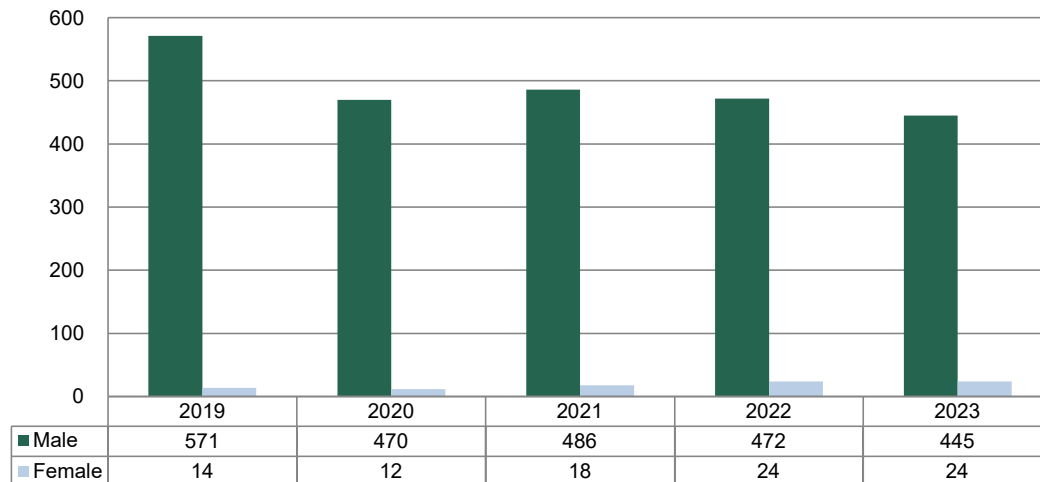

Premium rates - per \$100 assessable payroll



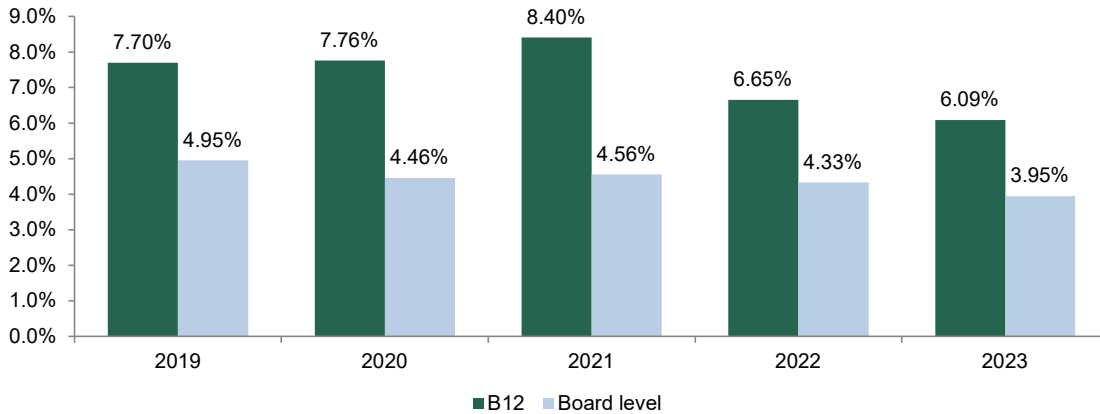

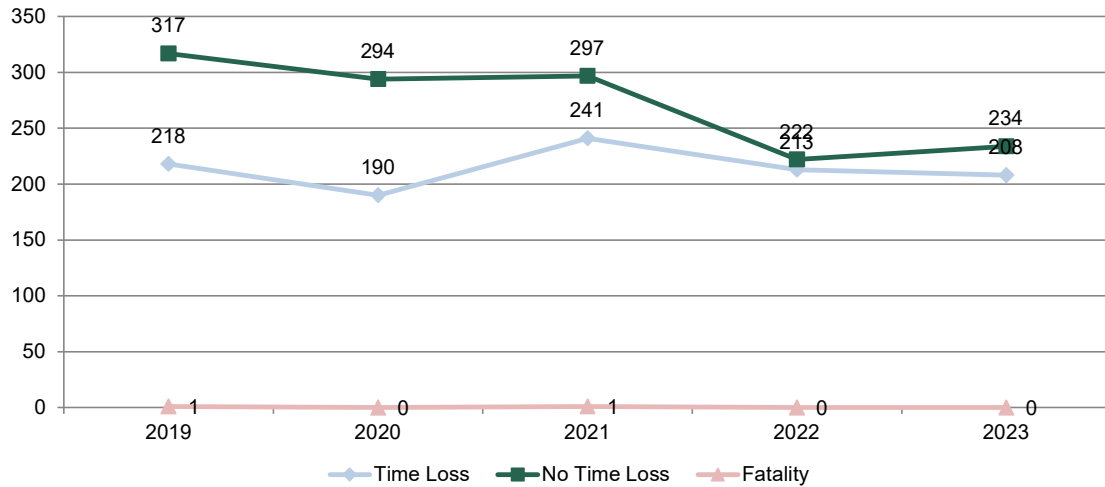

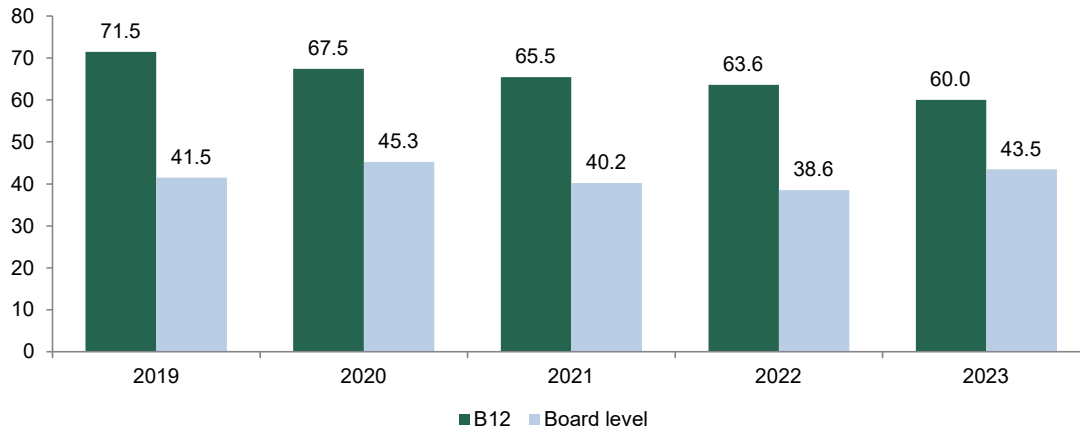
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

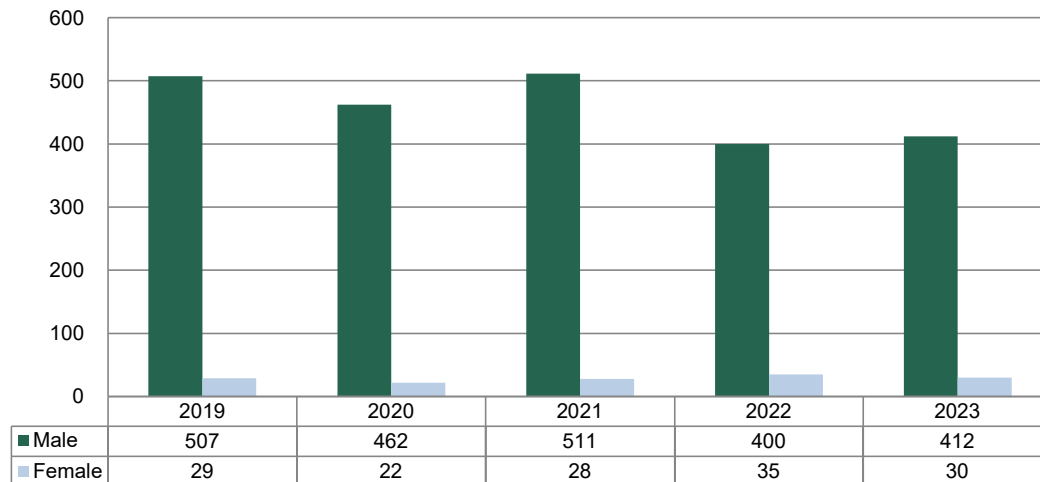

Premium rates - per \$100 assessable payroll



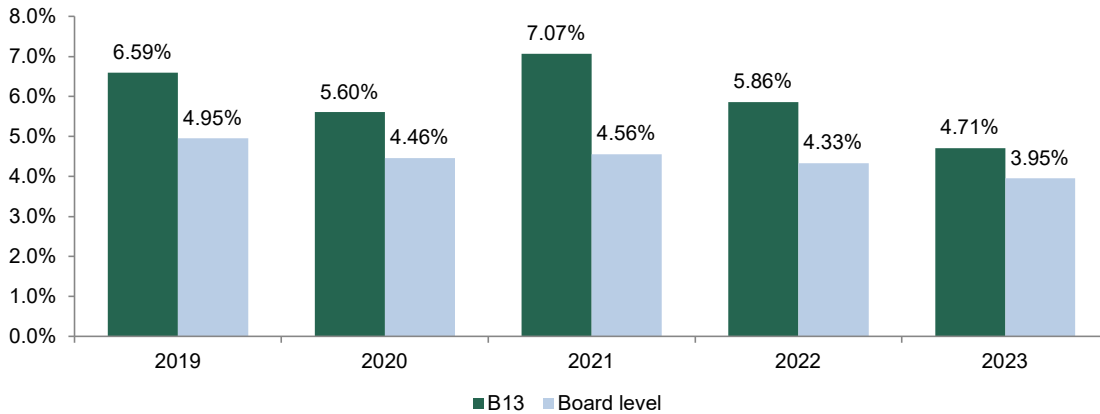

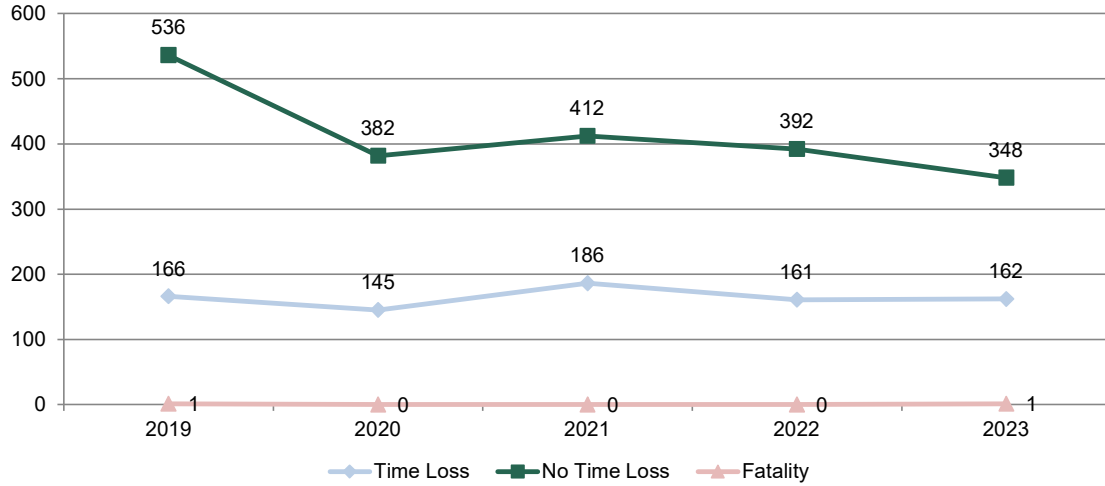

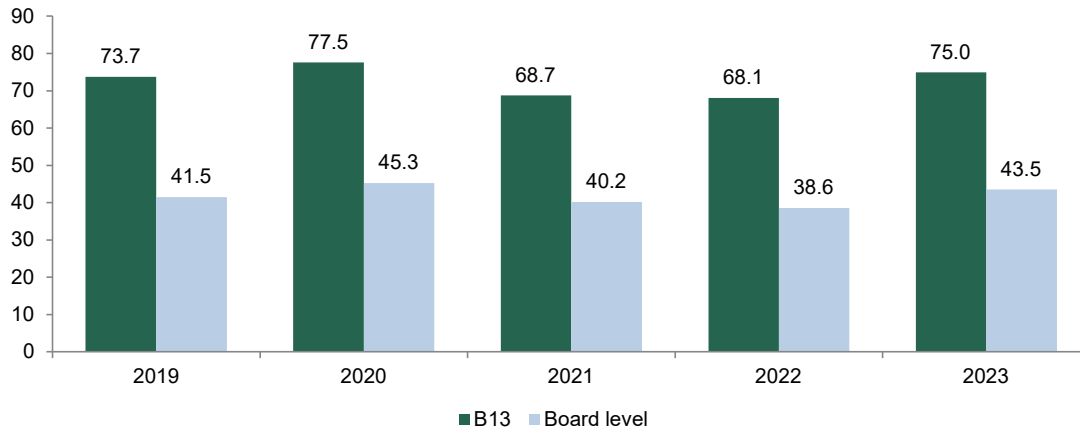
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

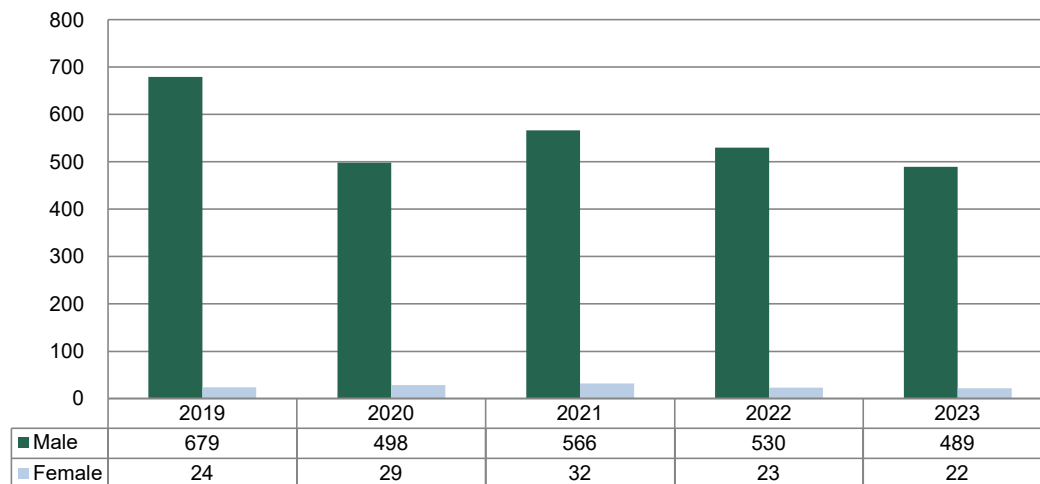

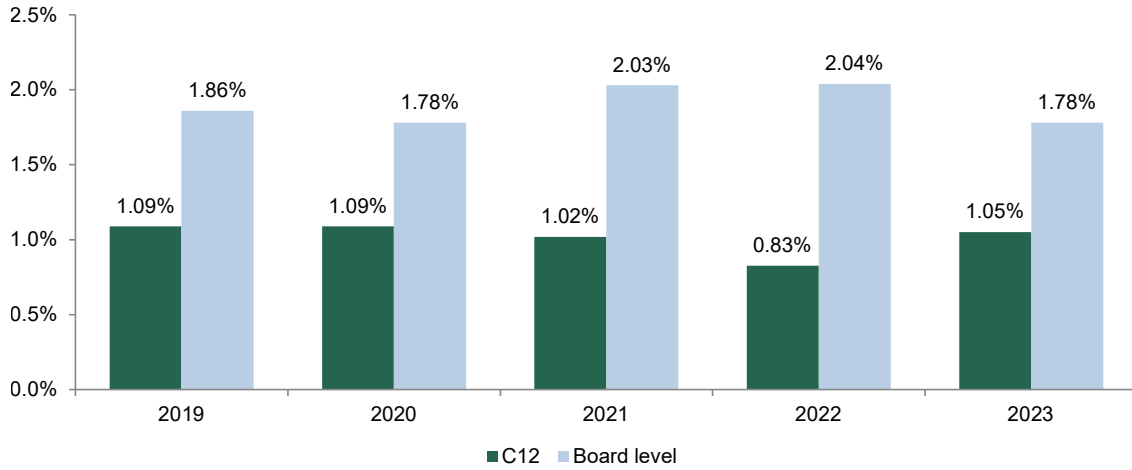

Premium rates - per \$100 assessable payroll



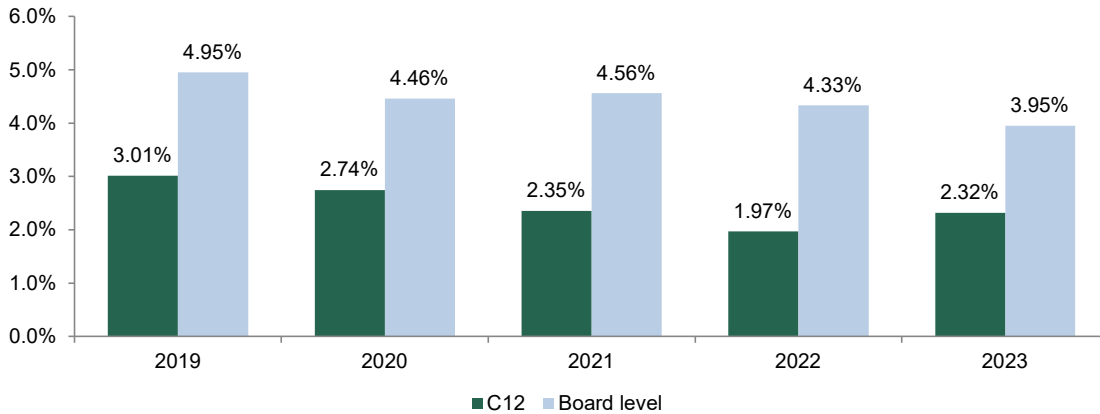

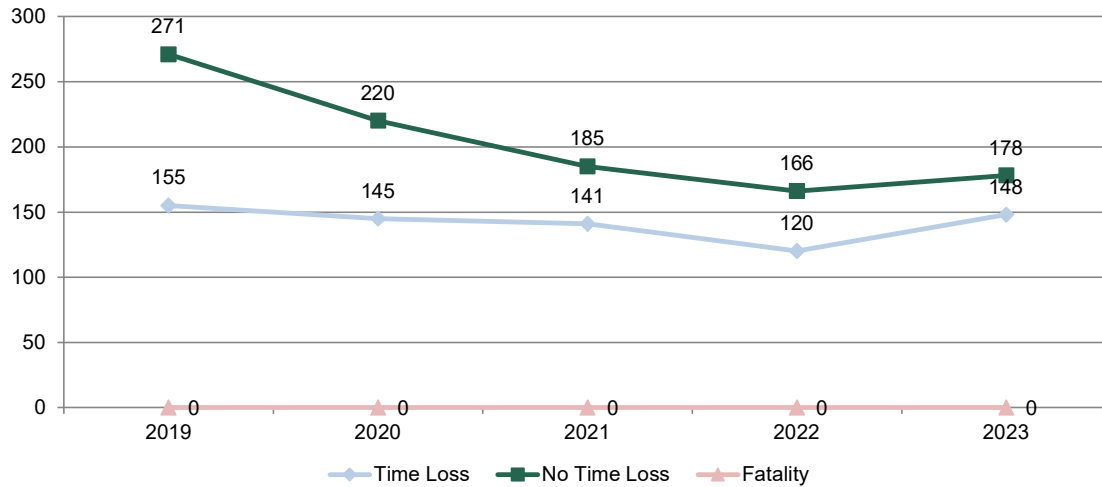

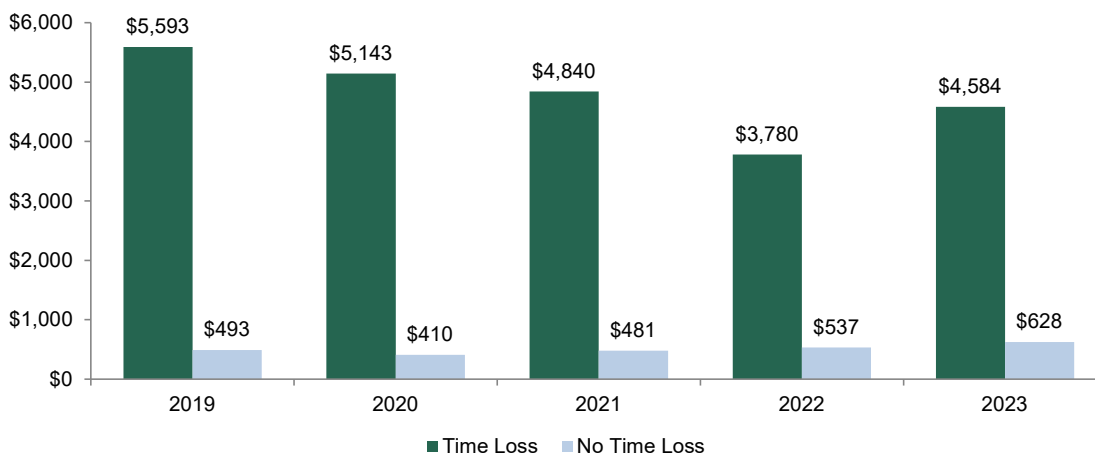

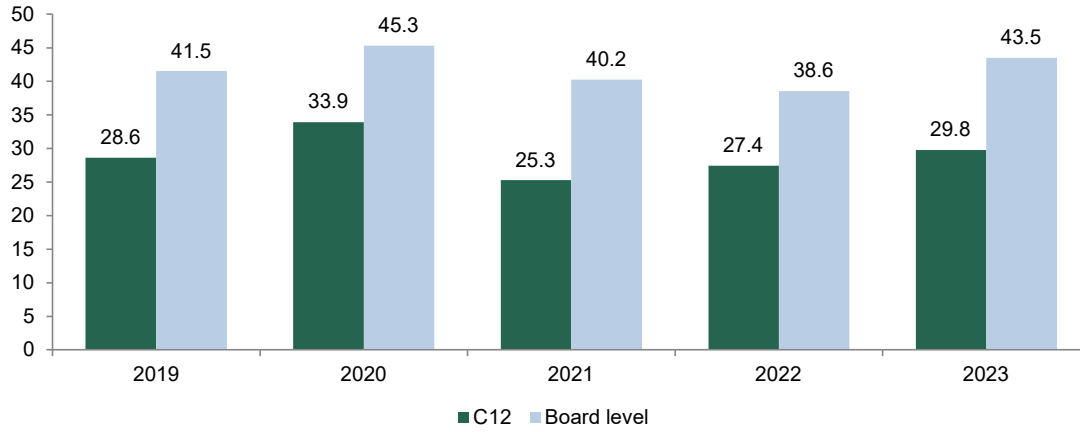
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

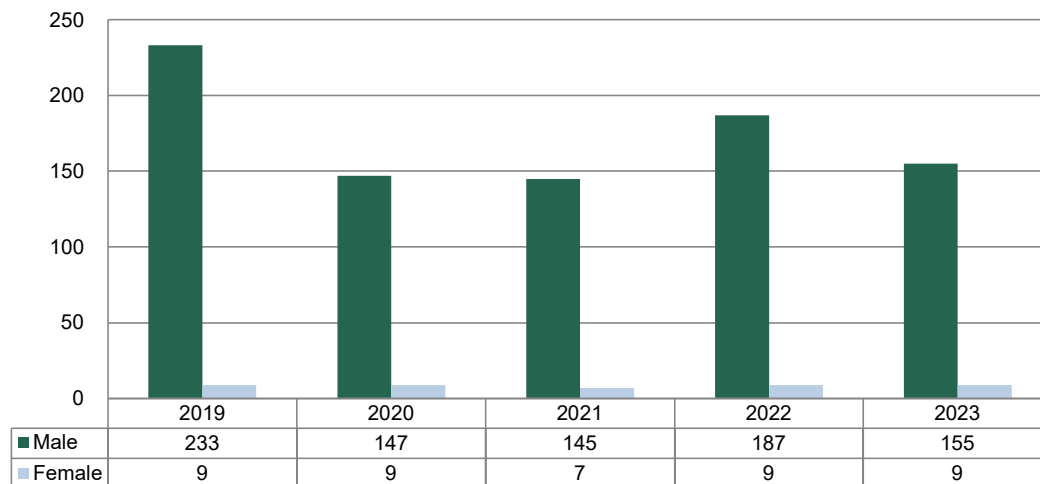

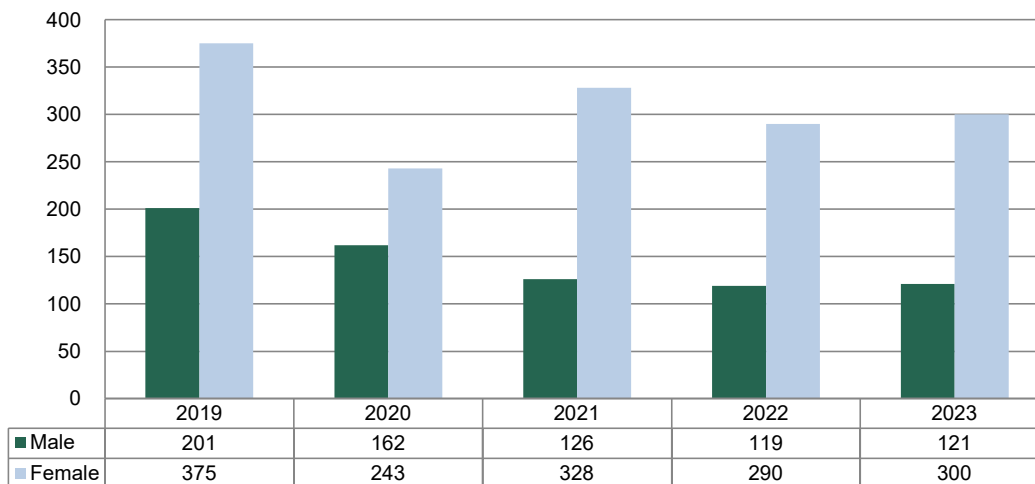

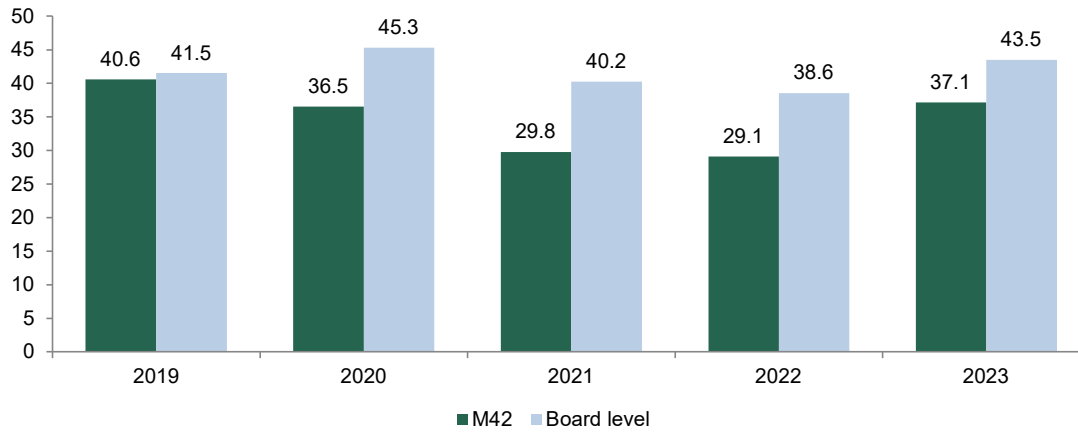

Time Loss injury rates*



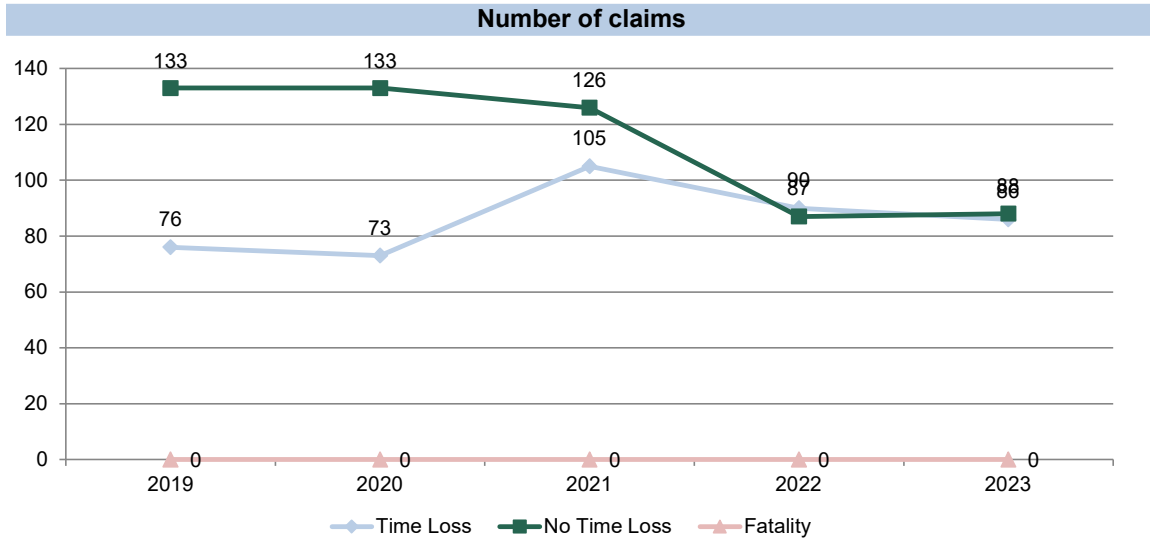

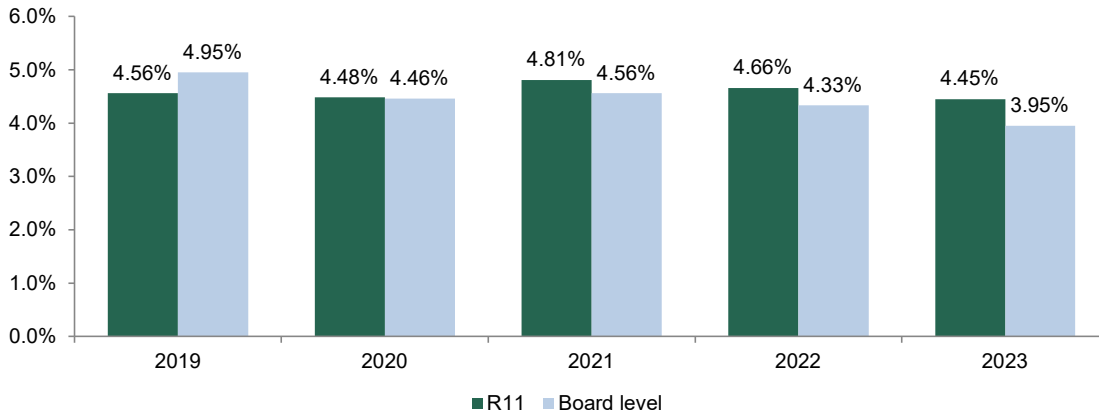

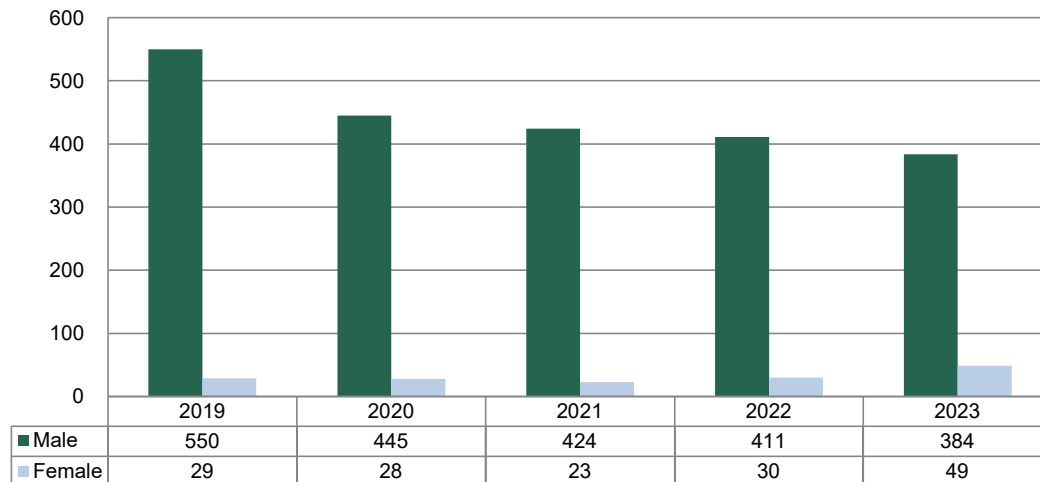

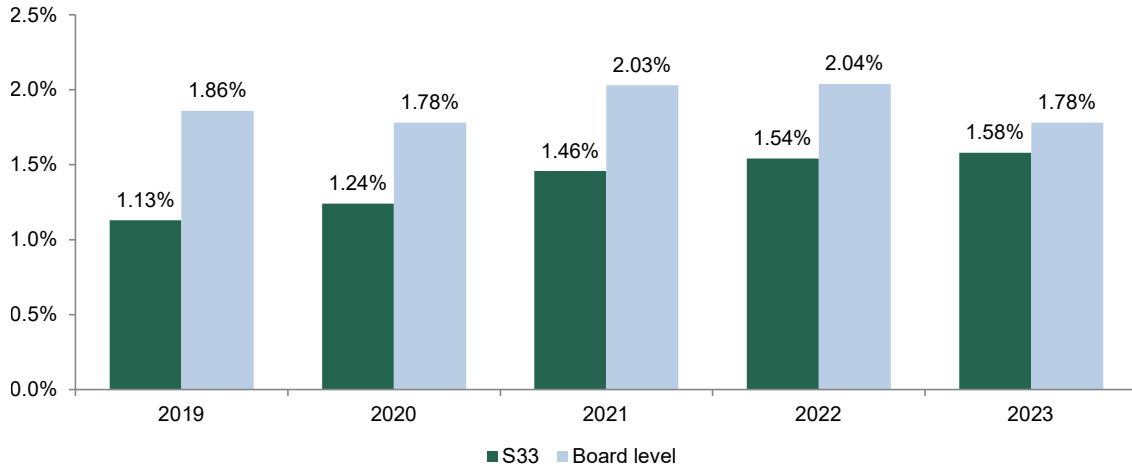

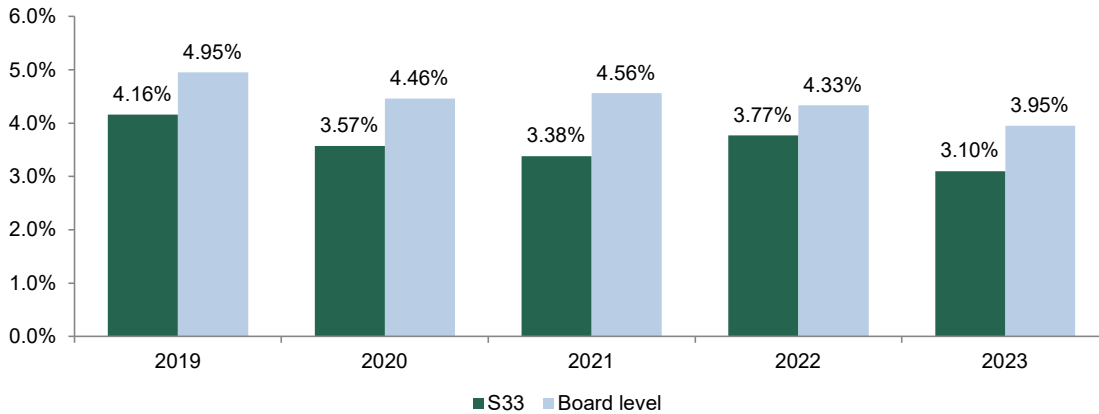

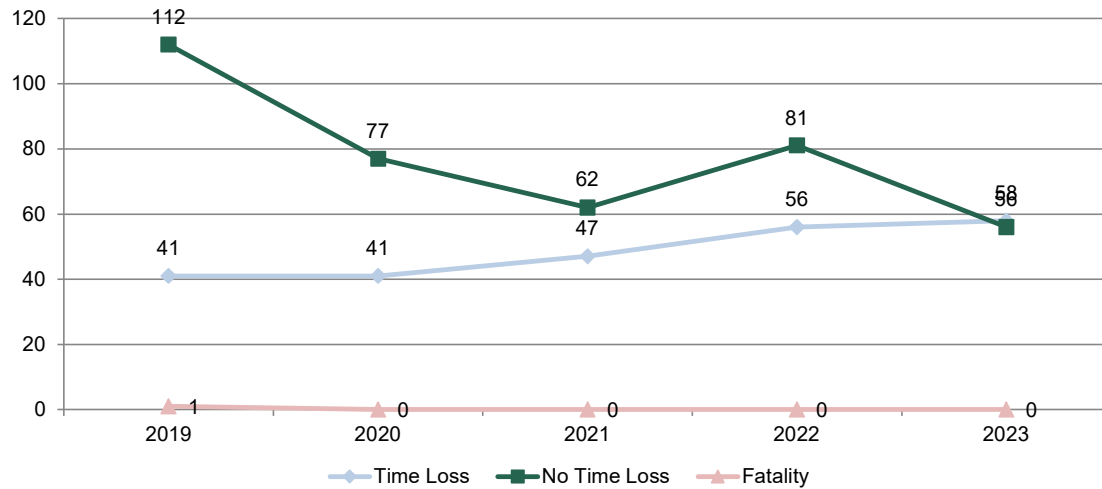

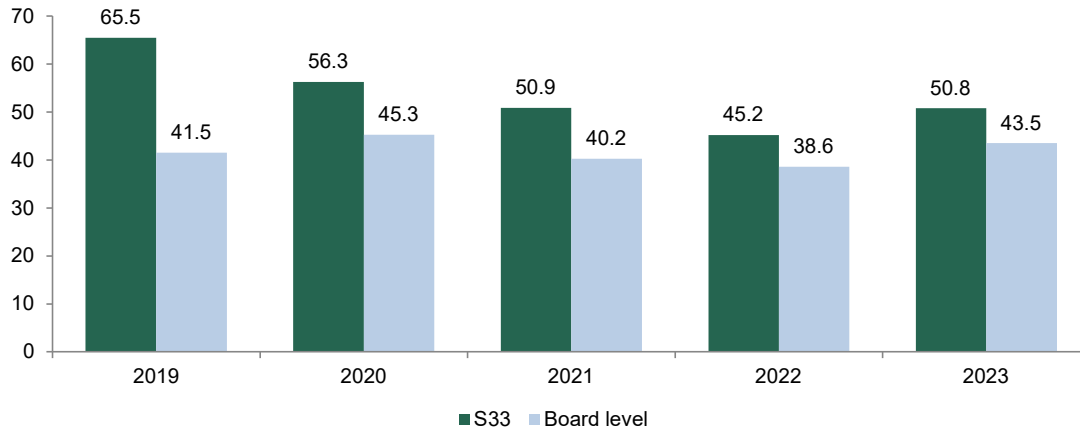

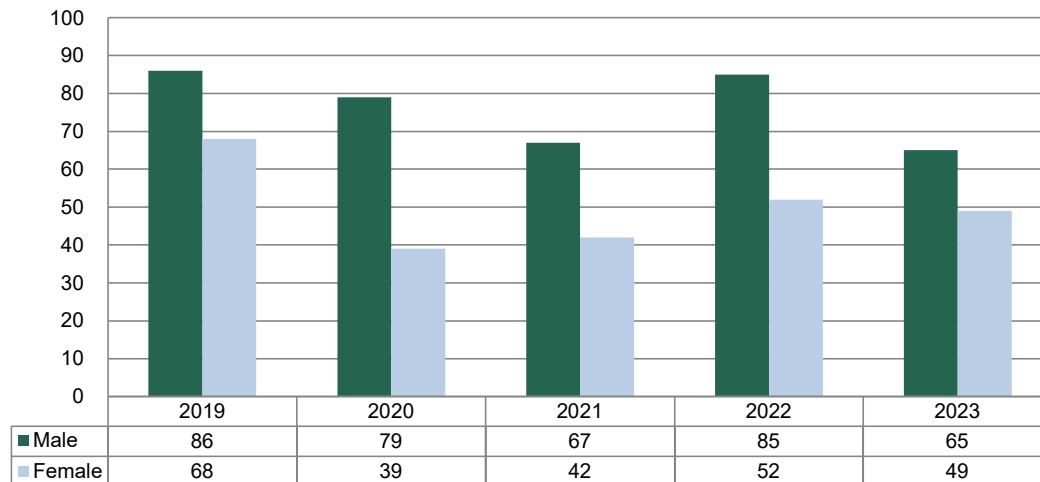

Premium rates - per \$100 assessable payroll



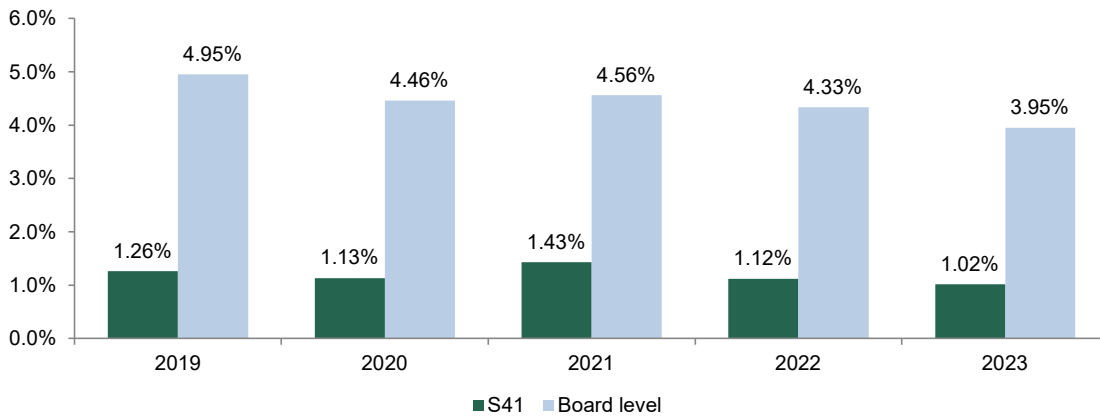

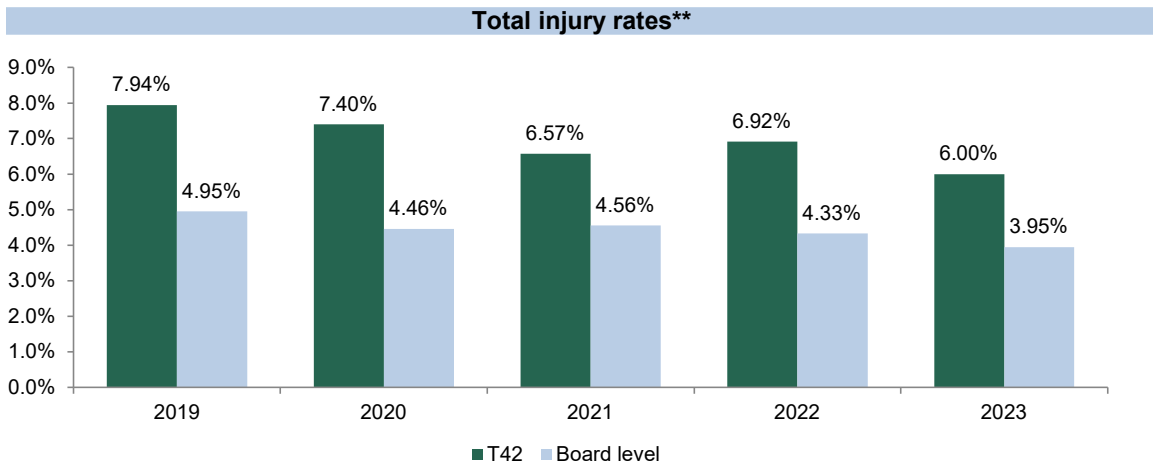
Premium rates - per \$100 assessable payroll

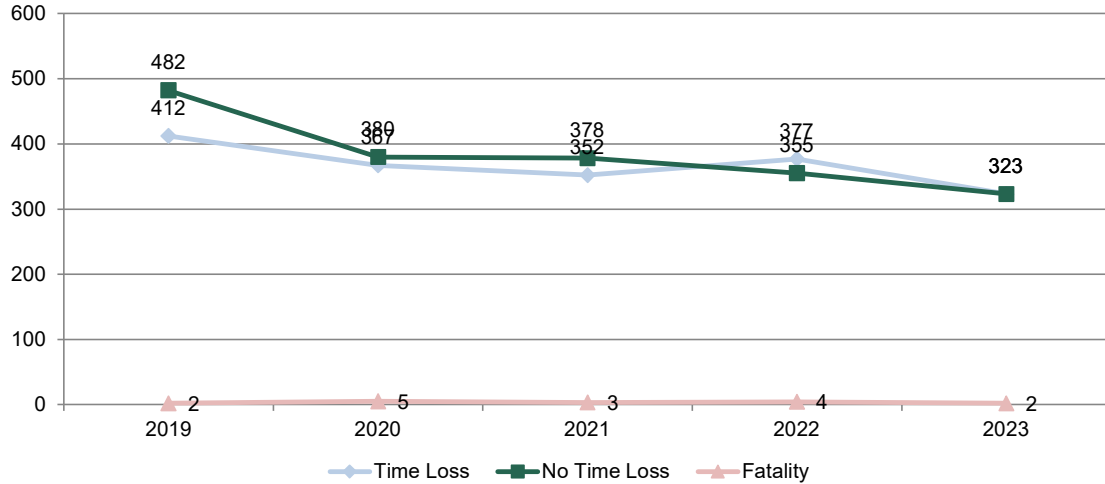

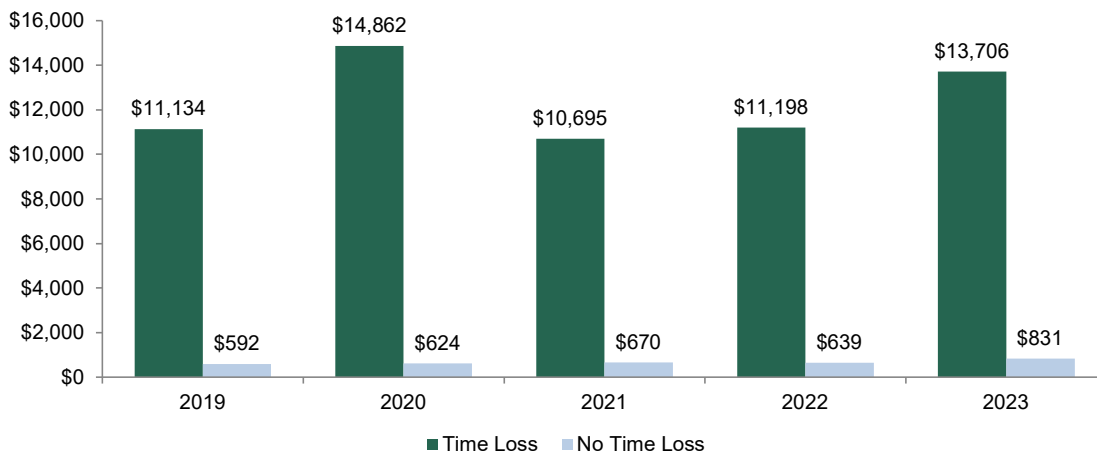

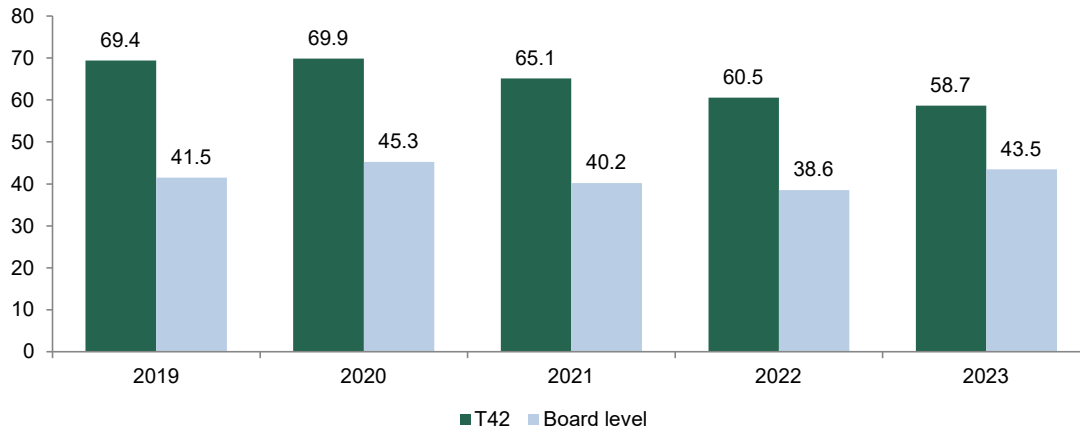
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

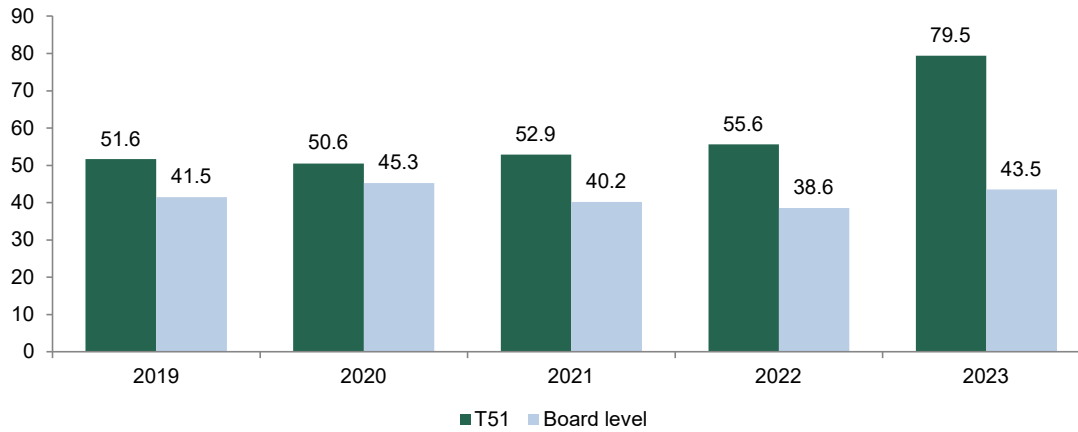
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

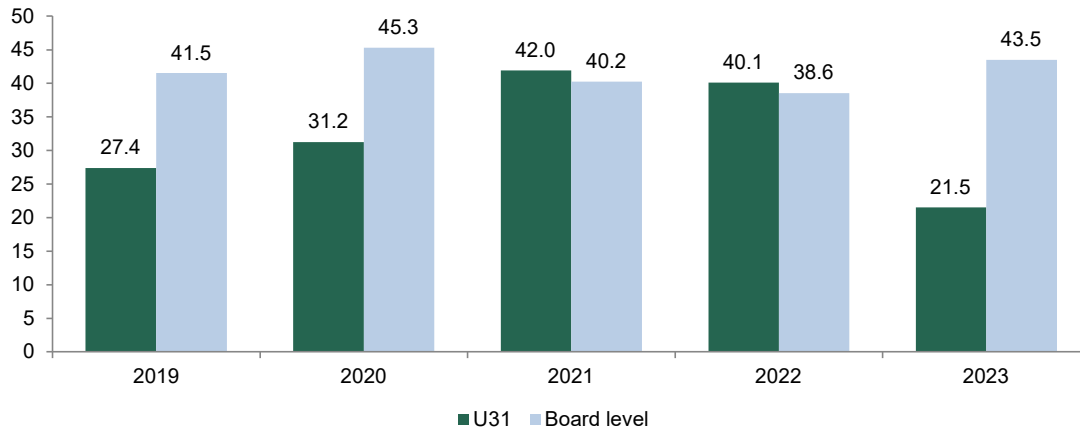
Average cost in registration year by claim type*

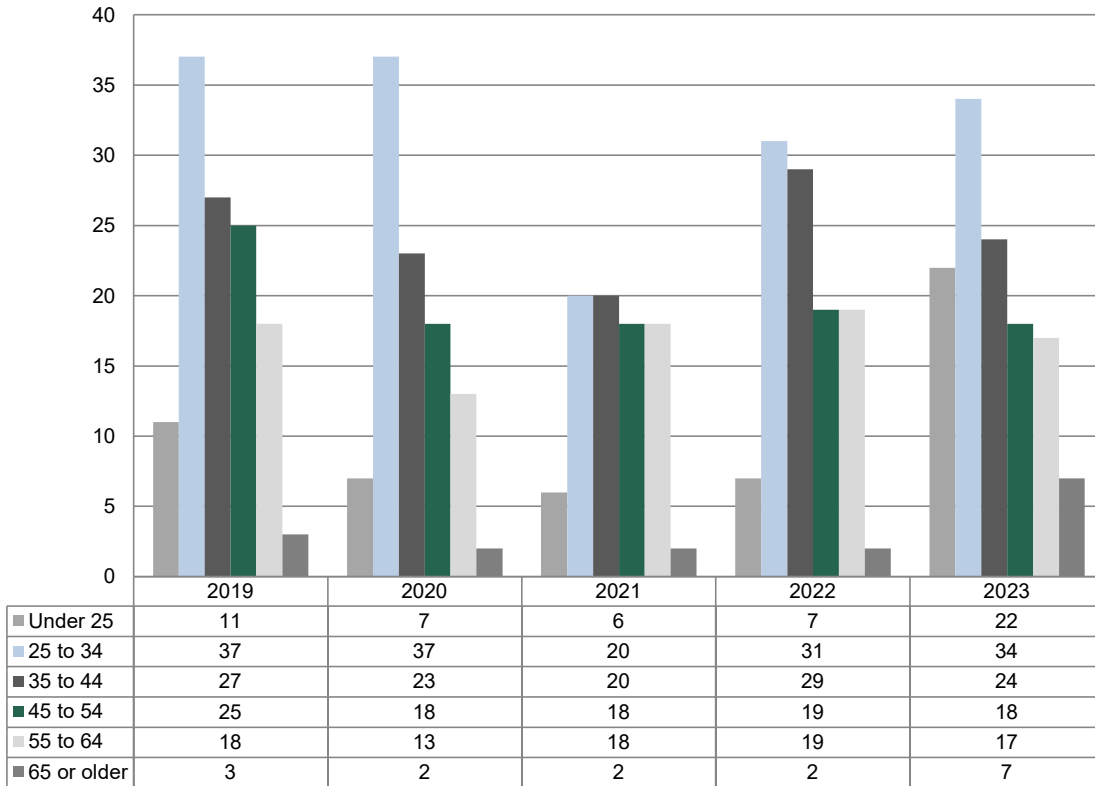

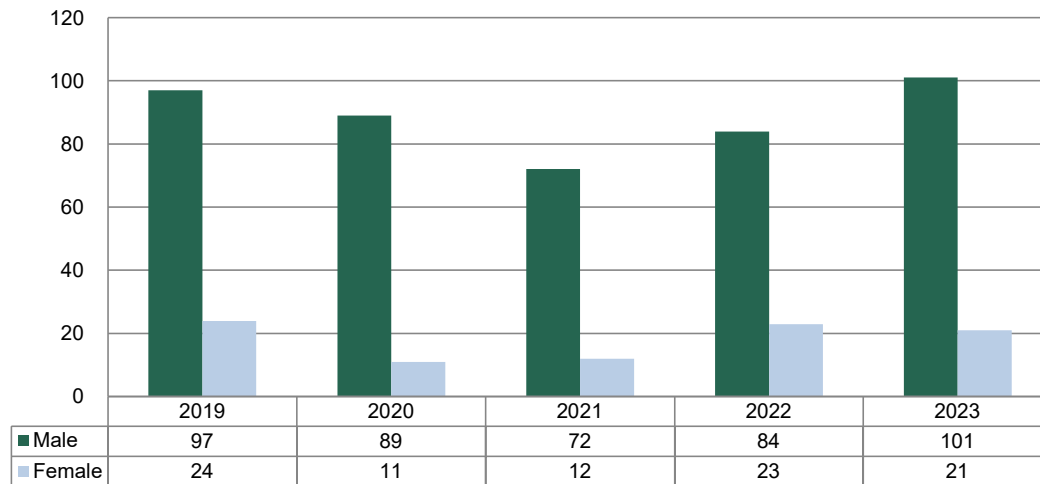
