

Access to Workers' Compensation Board Information

The Saskatchewan's Workers' Compensation Board (WCB) is separate from the government and follows [The Workers' Compensation Act, 2013](#) (the Act). We manage the compensation system for workers and employers. We also collect money from employers to pay for wage loss, medical care, pensions, and rehabilitation for injured workers.

All employer and injured worker information is confidential.

Under the Act, a worker, their representatives or, in the case of a death, their dependant(s) can get a copy of the claim record by making a request. The Act says that these records can only be given if it is for an appeal or review of a decision made by us.

Employers' can only have the right to parts of the claim record that were used to make a decision that the employer does not agree with. The worker has to approve the release of this information to the employer.

You may be able to get information, that is held by the WCB and is of a general nature (not claim file information), through *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FOIP Act). However, each application is considered on its own.
