# How are 2024 industry premium rates set? 

The Saskatchewan WCB sets industry premium rates annually. The rate setting process ensures today's employers pay for the costs of today's claims.

Updated payroll forecasts

| Assessable <br> payroll <br> (\$ millions) | Used in 2023 <br> rate setting | Updated 2023 <br> projection | 2024 <br> projection |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| T61 rate <br> code payroll | $\$ 105.22$ | $\$ 112.25$ | $\$ 114.03$ |

The overall reduction to the premium rate for T61 is the result of increasing payroll forecasted for 2024, which is combined with decreasing claims and related administration costs. The largest change in claims in dollar terms is related to short-term disability and vocational rehabilitation costs.

Top five causes of serious injuries in
T61: 2018-2022

1. exposure from witnessing or hearing about traumatic or stressful event, n.e.c.
2. fall on same level, n.e.c.
3. bending, climbing, crawling, reaching, twisting
4. struck by falling object
5. overexertion in lifting
