

# How to create and use your WCB online account

Workers and employers, consider a <u>WCB online account</u> to submit injury claim forms quickly and efficiently and for quick log in for claim status updates.

### Create your WCB online account in four easy steps.

- 1. On the <u>WCB online account</u> page, click "Create Account."
- 2. Enter your email address.
- 3. You will receive a verification email to confirm your email address. Enter the passcode from that email.
- 4. Enter in your first name and last name, and select a password. Read and agree to the terms and conditions. You now have a basic WCB online account.

To access your full online account, select "Request Account Access."

When you submit your forms online, the form is automatically entered into the WCB system, which eliminates delays that can occur if mailed.

Employers, to avoid delays in the claims process and to avoid any fines, **submit your E1 form within five days** of being told about the work injury.
